



The City of Sumner Request for Proposal (RFP)

Updating Shoreline Master Program

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: An update of the 2004 Shoreline Master Program (SMP) that is developed and adopted in a manner consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the Shoreline Management Act (SMA) and its implementing rules, including the Shoreline Master Program Guidelines. The SMP update process includes: 1) review and update shoreline inventory and analysis reports with corresponding maps and illustrations that characterize shoreline ecological conditions; 2) amendments to shoreline policies, environment designations, setbacks, and use regulations as needed; 3) analysis of cumulative impacts and uses; 4) preparation of a shoreline restoration plan; and 5) preparation of a formal local adoption process. Public participation will be incorporated in all phases of the SMP update to the degree necessary in light of the scope of the amendments and changes.
